DETAILS

- The top 14 entries in world ranking order at the close of entries will gain automatic acceptance to the Main event
- Players will be notified within 3 days of close of entry if they have been accepted into the Main event, or if they have been offered a place in the Qualifying event
- Players who miss out on automatic entry to the main event will have the option of entering the Qualifying event and receiving a refund of \$100, or withdrawing and receiving a full refund of \$150. This option is to be exercised within 48 hours of the offer being made
- A maximum of 16 entries will be accepted into the Qualifying event, which will run from Tuesday 23 February to Thursday 25 February. Two players will qualify from the Qualifying event for the Main event
- Entry fee for the qualifying event is \$50, and no further entry fee for the Main event is payable by the two players who qualify
- The Main event will be played initially in four blocks each of four players, followed by a double-elimination knockout. Block positions will be based on World Ranking order 7 days prior to the start of the event, with the winner and runner-up from the Qualifying event taking positions 15 and 16 respectively
- For the double-elimination knockout, block winners will be seeded to positions 1 to 4, runners-up will become players 5 to 8, etc., in such a fashion that each quarter of the draw has a player from each block
- The format and duration of the Qualifying event will depend upon the number of players taking part, but will be block play possibly followed by either a final or semifinals and a final
- There will be billets available for players who need them
- A travel subsidy will be available to players from Queensland, Victoria, South Australia (all \$100), Tasmania (\$150) and Western Australia (\$350)
- Three gift vouchers for Dixon Advisory services, worth a total of \$4,500, will be won by the players completing the most and longest peeling turns during the tournament
- Both the Qualifying event and the Main event will be played during the day and under lights in the evening. Atkins Quadway hoops will be used for all games, set to 3 11/16 inches
