Qualifying events will be held in up to 9 locations throughout NSW to encourage broad participation, with the local winners eligible to play in the State Final between 9-12 June 2017, at CNSW HQ at Tempe.

First round qualifying block matches will be arranged and played locally to accommodate maximum participation and need to be completed by about May 30.

Players who qualify for the finals will be eligible for a subsidy from Croquet NSW to assist with travel & accommodation costs.

Entry fees:

- \$15 per player to cover the initial block round
- Plus an additional \$15 for the final series qualifiers

Part of the entry fees go toward a pool for travel/accommodation subsidy for county players who make it to the final.
