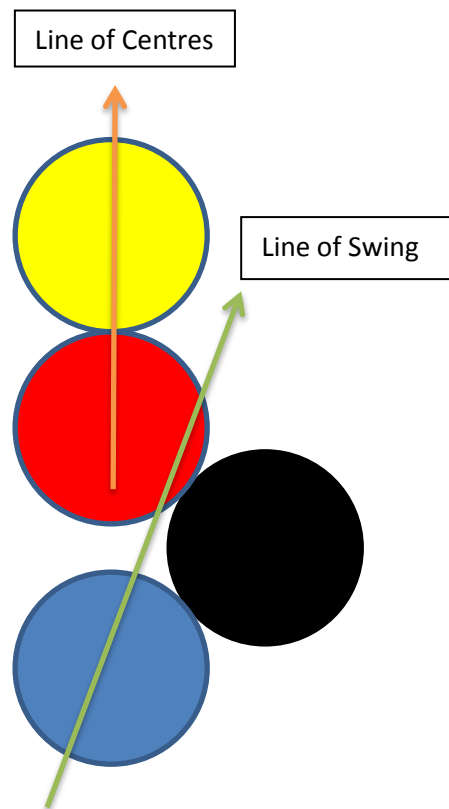


## 4 BALL CANNONS

These are not as common as three ball cannons but players should be aware of how best to play them. To help the description the striker's ball, the ball you are taking croquet from and the ball to be roqueted are called the first, second and third ball. The intention is to play a cannon and promote the fourth ball. The fourth ball can be promoted using the roqueted ball or the croqueted ball.

### Normal Four Ball Cannon

In this the fourth ball is promoted by the third ball in the cannon. Any movement of the third ball means that the fourth ball must travel along the line of centres.



### Non-standard Four Ball Cannon

This differs from the above since the forth ball, later to be croqueted is placed in contact with the ball from which you are taking croquet in the cannon.
