Croquet NSW Treasurer's Report - May 2020

Financial Statements

CNSW remains on track for a loss of \$8-10,000.

Very few players have asked for a refund for Croquet NSW events.

On the other hand the decision to pass on the ACA rebate has been very well received and more than half the rebate has now (Thursday May 14) been paid. If we have not already thanked ACA then we should do so.

The decision to reduce affiliation fees for 2020/21 has also been welcomed.

Investments

I have started the process of changing the authorised persons with Australian Unity and Cromwell Investments. The very limited liquidity of these investments means that they are not a suitable asset for an organisation such as CNSW. They are certainly not in the trustee class.

I hope to have a value update for the meeting.

State Team Handbook

At the time of writing the State Team handbook has been partially drafted. The current draft has been added to Our Cat Herder Documents.

CRCC

CRCC have advised that they are happy to stay with the current agreement and that my previous concerns were unfounded.

Croquet NSW Treasurer's Report – Addendum May 2020

Managed Funds

CNSW has investments in two managed funds

- Australian Unity Healthcare Property Trust
- Cromwell Direct Property Trust

The investments were made to provide a long term source if investment income for CNSW at a time when fixed interest rates were low. Both funds offer limited redemption with Cromwell offering monthly redemptions and Australian Unity, quarterly. Redemptions are limited to 1% of the funds on a first come first served basis.

Australian Unit have not provided an updated unit price since 30 March. They did finalise a property revaluation cycle in April (properties are valued on a three year cycle). As a result of this valuation there was an increase in values of 3.69%, mainly from lowering the capitalisation rate.

These investments would not be regarded as trustee investments but they have performed quite well for CNSW, achieving their aim of earning more than fixed interest.

New Members

I have processed 5 new members over the Covid-19 period. I have waived the membership fee which would have been \$10.50. Of course these members will be part the 1 July database on which our 2019/20 invoice will be based. After that date the normal charges will be made ie \$44

I recommend that we continue to make no charge for new members until 30 June.
