



Call for Expressions of Interest Australian Members of the WCF AC Laws Committee

Under WCF Statute 132, Croquet Australia is required to appoint a member of the WCF AC Laws Committee, such appointment being for a four (4) year term, commencing on 1st January after appointment.

The term of the current incumbent, Liz Fleming, ends on 31st December 2020, with Liz eligible to serve a second term.

Croquet Australia is calling for Expressions of Interest in appointment to this committee for the period 1st January 2021 to 31st December 2024. A copy of the Terms of Reference for the position is attached.

Expressions of Interest should include relevant experience and be in the hands of the Secretary by no later than 30th October 2020 to allow presentation to the Board in November and notification of the appointee to WCF by 1st December 2020.

WCF Laws/Rules Committee Members Terms of Reference

1. Authority for Appointment.

- 1.1. The Croquet Australia Representatives on the WCF AC Laws Committee and the WCF GC Rules Committee are authorised by the Board to carry out the undermentioned responsibilities and functions on behalf of the Board.
- 1.2. Appointments to these positions is authorised under WCF Statutes 132 and 133.

2. Appointment.

- 2.1. The Croquet Australia Representatives on the WCF AC Laws Committee and the WCF GC Rules Committee are appointed by the Board for a period of four years. Appointees are eligible to be appointed for a second four year term.
- 2.2. The WCF ACLC terms are 1st January 2017 to 31st December 2020, 1st January 2021 to 31st December 2024, and so on.
- 2.3. The WCF GCRC terms are 1st January 2019 to 31st December 2020m and so on.
- 2.4. In the case of a casual vacancy, Croquet Australia may appoint someone to fill the remainder of the term of that appointment.

3. Responsibilities. The Representatives shall:

- 3.1. represent Australia on the WCF AC Laws Committee or the WCF GC Rules Committee, as appropriate;
- 3.2. liaise with the Board, the relevant National Coordinator of Referees and other relevant officials on issues that may be dealt with by the relevant WCF committee;
- 3.3. advise the Board and the relevant National Coordinator of Referees of proposals by the relevant WCF Committee to seek amendments to the Laws/Rules;
- 3.4. ensure that the Laws or Rules, as appropriate, including Official Rulings or Commentaries are made widely available throughout Australia

4. Management

- 4.1. The Representative are responsible to the Board and accountable for all decisions made and actions taken in the performance of their duties.
- 4.2. The Representatives shall provide reports to the Board as requested and shall, in any case, provide a report for inclusion in the Croquet Australia Annual Report.
