



## **2023 AC Handicap Pennants**

### **Open Division.**

Handicaps -3 to 12. Higher handicaps may play but play on a handicap of 12.  
26-point advanced handicap play, 2 hours 30 time limit. Hoops set to 3 11/16 inches.

### **Restricted Division.**

Handicaps 14 to 20. At the close of entries date all players must have a handicap of 14 or higher, but if a player's handicap subsequently reduces to 12 (but not lower) they may continue to play using that handicap.

18-point handicap play, not advanced, clips on hoop 5 at the start of play, 2 hours 30 time limit.  
Hoops set to 3 12/16 inches.

### **General conditions.**

Tests to comprise 2 singles matches and 1 doubles match. There is no restriction on which of the 4 players play singles and which play doubles, and the No 1 singles can be either of the two players, regardless of handicap. All players to be members of the same club. Clubs may enter several teams in each division.

Depending on entries, teams will be formed into groups of not more than 6 teams, all within the one NSW Region. However if there are insufficient entries a group may contain teams from more than 1 region (subject to travel requirements). For smaller groups teams will play home and away, for larger groups a single round robin – there will be a maximum of 6 tests for each team.

Finals between group winners will be held at Tempe.

Once a draw has been published captains will arrange days and times for the tests. Where possible tests should be arranged for teams to arrive at 9:30 and play to commence at 10:00, but that can be modified. On arrival captains will exchange team sheets.

Players should bring their handicap cards but should also ensure the handicap on the CNSW website is up to date.
